We reviewed each funded service category and discussed the funding methodology from last year and reviewed the most recent data we have in each of those service categories. The following methodology was decided on:


OUTPATIENT AMBULATORY HEALTH SERVICES: uninsurable client count for Regions 1, 2, 3 and 5 (X) \$701 cost per client and unduplicated client count (total) in Region 4 (X) \$701 cost per client MEDICAL CASE MANAGEMENT: \$1475 cost per client (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region


ORAL HEALTH: : \$700 cost per client (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region SUBSTANCE ABUSE OUTPATIENT: \$3293 cost per client (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region

<u>HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM COST SHARING ASSISTANCE</u>: : \$425 cost per client (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region

MENTAL HEALTH: \$3300 cost per client (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region HOUSING SERVICES: 90% of the 2023 fair market rent for 1 bedroom for each region (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region

EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: \$641 cost per client (X) FY22 unduplicated client count for each region










