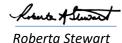

• Review Scope of Work for Next Year




Inthiany Ardila made a motion to approve the updated scope of work for GY2025 and Chris Cole seconded it.


